Encantado, an Auberge Resort

Opening in August, Encantado, Auberge Resorts' newest property, sister to famed Auberge du Soleil and Esperanza Resort, will make its debut as the ultimate romantic hideaway in the Southwest. Encantado's 65 beautifully designed casitas include nine suites, ranging from 630 to 925 square feet, each displaying a contemporary interpretation of traditional Santa Fe design. Stucco exteriors in soft earth tones with rich chocolate wood trim lead into the contemporary adobe-style casitas with oversized windows and kiva-style fireplaces, all of which spill into the indulgent bathroom with deep soaking tubs and heated floors. Luxury amenities include state-of-the-art technology, plasma screen televisions, original artwork, and his-and-hers closets and dressing areas. Private terraces with plush furniture will set the stage for magnificent mountain views. Rates range from \$325 to \$975 nightly.

True to Auberge Resorts' legacy, inspired cuisine and a sophisticated wine program will be central to the character and experience of Encantado. The resort's fine-dining restaurant, Terra, will draw upon local techniques and organic seasonal produce utilizing the finest ingredients to create memorable regional cuisine.

The full-service 10,000-square-foot spa will feature an innovative selection of spa and wellness services that honor healing traditions indigenous to the region. The spa's design will incorporate the surrounding outdoor environment with outdoor soaking tubs and showers and mineral plunge pools. Guests may also opt to take a meditative walk through the labyrinth, which is artfully incorporated into the spa grounds. With 15 treatment rooms and suites, the healing arts offered at Encantado will include massage and body work, Ayurvedic rituals, Asian medicine traditions, regionally inspired treatments, and Western herbalism. Freestanding couples spa suites allow for private romance rituals and escapes. The resort's fitness center will offer state-of-the-art equipment and physical training and a dedicated movement studio for yoga, Pilates, and meditation.

Encantado will be the perfect location for meetings, events, and special celebrations; the one-of-a-kind setting offers flexible indoor and outdoor facilities that include a 2,600-square-foot ballroom and a boardroom with dedicated breakout space.

Speaking to an essential Auberge hallmark, Encantado will incorporate a rich collection of contemporary, local, and regional artwork throughout the property. Furthering the arts experience, Encantado will feature an on-site art gallery, expansive outdoor sculpture garden, and art and photography programs for inspired guests.
